The group shall be called

Aim of the Group

The aim of the group is to promote co-operation between the Practice and Patients to the benefit of both.

Membership

Membership of the group is open and free to all registered patients.

Structure

Structure of the group will consist of:

- Chair
- Vice Chair
- Secretary

Nominations will be sought annually and for each office and a vote will be taken should there be more than one nomination.

Meetings

The group will endeavour to meet no fewer than 2 times a year. Meetings will be held at Kearsley Medical Centre.

Recording

Minutes will be recorded by the Secretary for every meeting and these will be published on Kearsley Medical Centre website and printed and displayed on the notice board in the waiting room.

At times, when confidential matters are discussed, the minutes will be divided into Part A and Part B. Part A will be published and Part B will have restricted access to the group.
